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| <b>Agenda Item:</b>                           | <p>Study sessions relating to the County update of the Stanford University Community Plan (Community Plan). Stanford University lands, located within unincorporated Santa Clara County, are governed by the goals, policies, and programs in the Community Plan that is a part of the Santa Clara County General Plan.</p> <p>The primary purpose of the Community Plan is to guide future use and development of Stanford University lands in a manner that incorporates key General Plan principles of compact urban development, open space protection, and resource conservation. The Community Plan, as part of the General Plan, is comprised of the following elements: Growth and Development, Land Use, Housing, Circulation, Open Space, Resource Conservation, and Health and Safety.</p> <p>The Community Plan is also consistent with and furthers the implementation of associated planning documents such as the 1985 Land Use Policy Agreement among Stanford University, the City of Palo Alto, and the County of Santa Clara.</p> |
